


Click on the Stage icon to the lower right



A new scripting window will appear, if you press the spacebar a background will appear on the stage





If you click on “Backgrounds” you will see what “costumes” are being used




But how do you import your own?

If your computer has a camera, one option is to take a picture of yourself or a friend by clicking on the camera icon



But you can also find an image and save it to your computer. Then import it into your project by going to “file” and “import”. Then select the image from your computer. It should then appear in the list of backgrounds.



Then right click the image and select “edit” to change the size of the image to fit your stage.
